

What to expect with treatment

Generally, each treatment takes about 15 to 20 minutes, and you may need more than one treatment to see best results. Your doctor will discuss when and how often you will receive these treatments.⁵ In most cases, they are spaced about 3 to 8 weeks apart.⁷

In clinical studies, no anesthetic was used.⁷ Some people experience temporary redness, discomfort, or pain immediately after treatment.⁵

Check with your PicoWay Resolve provider about any pre- or post-treatment care.

Low to no downtime^{5,6}

PicoWay Resolve treatment has low to no downtime.^{5,6} Most clinical study patients said they had mild to no discomfort.⁷ Mild side effects like redness, swelling, and tingling cleared within days after treatment.⁶

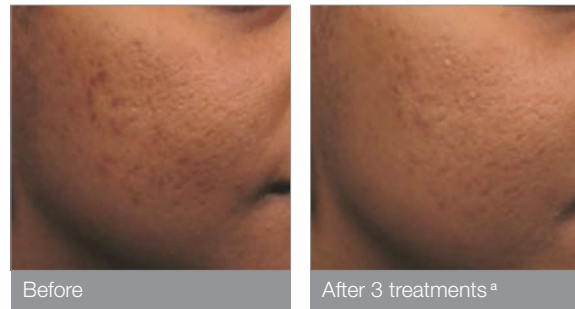
In fact, an estimated 40% of patients with acne develop acne scars,¹ which may worsen over time.³
